

AREA 53 AD HOC COMMITTEE ON RE-DISTRICTING

The following proposals have been given to Glen and requested to be on the June Agenda.

There was quite a discussion about the appropriateness of designating a building as a district and it was felt that it was not a good long term strategy. The Pyramid Club has seen many changes over the years and is currently home to 6 active groups. It was the committees' consensus that there is no need to maintain District 42 as a separate district as the groups can very easily be absorbed by District 36.

The Area 53 Ad hoc Committee on Redistricting has agreed and therefore moves that District 42(The Pyramid Club) be dissolved and the district designation for the currently active groups be changed to District 36.

The Area 53 Ad hoc Committee on Redistricting has agreed and therefore moves that District 41(RAC Building) be dissolved. All groups have found other meetings places in other districts so there is no need to maintain this district designation.

After careful consideration, we came to the conclusion that Districts 28 and 29 have been acting in tandem for quite some time. With a combined active group count of 21, it would seem to be ideal to officially merge the two districts.

In keeping with our decision that any merger of districts should be designated by the lowest district number, the Area 53 Ad hoc Committee on Redistricting has agreed and therefore moves that Districts 28 and 29 be combined to a single district designated as District 28.
